## Week 2: Our Life Spins Around What We Treasure Most



### LET'S GET STARTED

Here is a game idea and a song to help you start thinking about the big idea

**TREADURE HUNT:** It's time for a treasure hunt! You can do this however you want (as complicated or easy as you'd like). Maybe you could hide the words from today's Bible verse (Matthew 6:21). Maybe you could hide toys or special things that you treasure. You could even include a set of clues or a treasure map. It's completely up to you. Have fun!

### INTRODUCE THE BIG IDEA

Let's start thinking about the big idea for this week.

**BIG IDEA:** Did you watch our Kidz Biz welcome video with the second episode of *Church Ladies*? If worship is like a spinning top, we need to find out what our life spins around. Our treasure (what we love most) shows us what we worship.

**BIG QUESTION:** What people, places and things do you love most? If you were isolated in your own home for a long time (like right now!) what people and things couldn't you live without? What place do you desperately want to go to when we can travel again?



### EXPLORE THE BIBLE TOGETHER

Look up the Bible passage together using a Bible translation or Bible App that is suitable for your children.

**BIBLE PASSAGE:** Read **Matthew 6:21** in a translation of the Bible which is helpful for your family. Jesus is saying here that what we treasure, shows what is in our heart (literally what is at the centre of our being). Jesus taught that being part of his kingdom is the greatest treasure we can discover. Read the two short parables in **Matthew 13:44-46**. One story is about a treasure in a field. The other is about a hidden pearl. God is saying in these two parables that when we discover Jesus and his kingdom, we will see they are so good we will want to give up everything else, just so that we can have him!



### WHAT DOES IT ALL MEAN?

Let's spend some time together talking about what this means for us, our church and our friends who don't know Jesus.

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Can you think of as many ways as you can to describe how Jesus is like an amazing treasure?
2. Have you got a story from your own life or your family about discovering Jesus and giving up everything so that they could receive him? How can you keep discovering Jesus as your treasure throughout the week? Going for a walk together outside? Reading or singing God's words? Telling stories? Praying as your share a meal together?



### PRAY TOGETHER

Let's pray together as we finish. Plus, there's an activity to help you engage with the big idea during the week.

**PRAY:** Use the ideas you thought of before (how Jesus is a treasure) and use them to pray. Maybe you could make a treasure chest and adds these words (written on golden coins into the treasure chest).
